- The winning team from each subtopic focus will be awarded a **cash prize of CAD \$25,000**, and all participants will be invited to attend the UofT AI annual conference where the ProjectX award ceremony will take place. - This year, ProjectX is focused on **Health**, with subtopics focusing on **Epidemiology, Clinical Practice, and Genetics**.
