THINGS TO NOTE

- All core and elective courses need to be upper-division.

MAJOR/MINOR COURSE LIMITS

- CogSci majors can take up to 2 core courses and 3 electives outside of the COGS department at UC San Diego.
- CBN majors can take up to 5 upper-division courses outside of UC San Diego.
- CogSci minors are approved to take one outside course towards their minor requirements.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

- To graduate you need at least 180 total units, and at least 60 upper-division units. The CogSci major includes about 48 upper-division units.
